Dear Parents and Carers

We are very excited to see our Year 10 and 12 students from the 15th of June and have been busy preparing the site to ensure the safety of our students and staff. We ask that students arrive in full school uniform, including their blazer and school shoes.

Food

Please note that our canteen is closed. We will be supplying a free packed lunch for all students attending, which students can order in morning registration (see menu attached). We will also be offering a free light breakfast (such as toast or bagels) to those who would like it. Of course, your child is welcome to bring their own packed lunch should they wish to do so. As the canteen will not be open, your child may want to bring their own snack for break-time.

Students are asked to bring a full water bottle with them to school.

Safety Video

Mr Clarke has recorded a welcome back greeting for students to watch before they return to school. This will give students an insight and hopefully address some questions they might have over the changes we have made to make the school ready for their return.

Travel to school

Students using all forms of public transport will be required to wear a face covering, as per the Government guidelines (see link below). The face covering does not need to be a medical mask, but can be a material covering, scarf or similar, provided it covers both your mouth and nose. You will not be able to travel if you do not have a way of covering your face. This must be worn before entering the vehicle and kept on at all times.
