CHANGES IN ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE START OF TERM 3

I do hope that you have been able to rest and recuperate over the holidays.

As you will be aware, the Government has announced further direction as to how students will return to school this month. Given that these arrangements are subject to change, we are regularly reviewing the situation and will keep you updated on a week by week basis.

On Monday 4 January, the school will be closed to all students, with the exception of those whose parents/carers have already requested provision through the key worker link. If you require your child to attend key worker provision from Tuesday 5 January, please click <u>here</u>.

Between Tuesday 5 January and Friday 8 January all other students should remain at home and complete their work remotely on Google Classroom. Work will be uploaded by teachers on Monday 4 January.

A further letter explaining arrangements for students taking public examinations in January will be sent out on Monday 4 January.

As national arrangements currently stand, on Monday 11 January, all Year 11 and Year 13 students should return to school as normal. All other students will need to continue to work from home. Should this position change we will let you know. In any event, we will write to you on Wednesday 6 January with updated arrangements.
