The Sittingbourne School Specialist Provision Opportunities



A Brief Overview

Students at The Sittingbourne School with Educational Health Care Plans are offered a range of exposures to a selection of options for their future. Beginning with a whole school approach to careers in all curriculum areas, students are encouraged to discuss their aspirations, and ambitions for their own futures and have the opportunity to speak to teachers in their various subjects about those career paths.

The Sittingbourne School also offers our students the chance to speak to real life professionals from a range of backgrounds in our careers fair; students can have mock interviews, ask questions, and experience speaking to people that they are unfamiliar with. We also support students in attending open days and school visits to various colleges and specialist provisions to assist children and their families when making the right choice for their future.

When approaching Year 10 and 11, students are introduced to Mrs Seymour who works 1:1 in meetings with students to find the best provider of further education or apprenticeship scheme to suit each child. Below is a thorough list of providers that are suitable for children with an EHCP with open days and courses available.

Intent

As part of the provision at The Sittingbourne School, our students are invited to explore a range of different avenues with regards to their future away from The Sittingbourne School. It is imperative that every student no matter their SEND/EHCP circumstances, is entitled to work towards a career goal that they are passionate about.

We communicate regularly regarding open evenings to families to ensure that students are given opportunities to visit a variety of colleges and provisions that will allow them to continue their education/training whilst staying in education until the age of 18.

Career fairs are a huge part of this programme which allows for students to speak to a range of companies/educators to find out what they can expect from their experiences.
