



16 to 19 Tuition Funding statement 2021-22

At The Sittingbourne School Sixth Form the 16 to 19 Tuition Fund is being used as follows:

The fund will be used to provide small group tuition for sixth form students who have not yet achieved a grade 4 or above in English and/or maths.

Students with special educational needs and disabilities, who require additional tuition to help them catch up with their studies, will also be supported by this provision.

Students studying A Levels and BTEC examination units, will be provided with 1:1, or small group tuition and intervention (no more than 5 in a group) to support their preparation for January 2022 and Summer 2022 examinations.

Student selection for the additional support will be measured by prior online engagement and achievement on their individual qualifications to date, as well as prior GCSE attainment in Summer 2021 TAGS.

The tuition sessions will be scheduled in addition to the planned programme of study for the students. Tuition and additional support may be delivered using a blend of online and in-school delivery using qualified subject teachers, or core subjects external tutors.

Tuition support offered will be based on an individual needs' assessment, examples of some of the Tuition Support we will offer include:

- GCSE re-sit preparation
- Tutor2U online individual A Level grade booster programme
- Academic mentoring
- Subject specific support for all courses ranging from Level 2 up to and including Level 3 and A Levels - additional small group tuition during school holidays and after the school day.

The impact of these sessions will be monitored based on student performance and progress in their courses and their preparation for and confidence in applying to future destinations, including higher education, employment and apprenticeships.
